List of prohibited items

Spectators are prohibited to bring into the official sports competition venue and use:

- weapons of any kind, including self-defence weapons, ammo, piercing or cutting objects, other items that can be used as a weapon, explosive, poisonous, toxic or odorous substances, radioactive materials;
- flammable or pyrotechnical substances and objects (other than matches and pocket lighters), including signal lights, flares, firecrackers, gas cylinders and items (chemicals) that can be used to manufacture pyrotechnical objects or generate smoke,
- other substances, objects, items (including makeshift items) that can be used to generate smoke or flames;
- devices and items (including makeshift items) other than pyrotechnics, which are used to disperse or spray various materials and substances (party poppers);
 - colouring substances;
 - wind instruments for producing sounds (including vuvuzelas, horns and pipes);
 - alcoholic beverages of any kind, narcotic or toxic substances or stimulants;
 - soft drinks in glass or tin containers or in plastic containers more than 0.5 litres in volume;
- propaganda materials of an extremist nature or those containing Nazi symbols or symbols of extremist organisations;
- devices that can interfere with the conduct of the official sports competition or create a disruption for players (laser pointers, light torches), radios, acoustic amplifiers (other than means of support mentioned in the Annex to this Code of Conduct);
- bulky items¹ that inconvenience other fans, except where the official sports competition organiser has allowed fans to bring such bulky items.

Means of support that can be used at the active support sectors

Bullhorn	any	Power rating: 200 W max; no more than 1 unit per sector of the sports venue; may be used only in active support sectors, unless otherwise approved by the official sports competition organiser
Drum	up to 60 cm in diameter and up to 40 cm high	bottomless or with a transparent bottom
Wind instruments for producing sounds (pipes and horns)	any	sound level: up to 90 dB and up to 120 dB; may be used only in active support sectors, unless otherwise approved by the official sports competition organiser
Flag	up to 2 m x 1.5 m affixed to poles up to 1.5 m long and 2.5 cm in diameter	only on hollow plastic (telescoping) poles; Russian translation of inscriptions in foreign languages or languages of the peoples of Russia, notarised or certified by the official sports competition organiser; may be used only in active support sectors, unless otherwise approved by the official sports competition organiser
Stretch banner	up to 2 m x 1.5 m	availability of a fire safety certificate; Russian translation of inscriptions in foreign languages or languages of the peoples of Russia, notarised or certified by the official sports competition organiser
Hanging banner	any	availability of a fire safety certificate; Russian translation of inscriptions in foreign languages or languages of the peoples of Russia, notarised or certified by the official sports competition organiser; may be used only in active support sectors, unless otherwise approved by the official sports competition organiser
Hanging flag	any	

The means of support mentioned in the Annex to this Code of Conduct, which do not meet the requirements applicable to them, may be brought to the venue only with preliminary approval from the official sports competition organiser or the entity authorised by the organiser as well as from entities tasked with maintaining public order and ensuring public safety during official sports competitions.

To obtain approval of these means of support spectators may submit a written application to the official sports competition organiser no later than 2 days before the date of the official sports competition, unless the official sports competition organiser has established a shorter period for such submission.
